The State of South Carolina Greenville District
Know all men by these presents that I Benjamin Huddleston
of the district and State aforesaid for & his consideration of the
sum of Four Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by James Gill-
iland of the District aforesaid have Granted bargained and
sold & by these Presents do Grant bargain & sell unto the said James
Gilliland all that tract or parcel of Land wherein, lying on both
sides of Ogallamp Creek, "W^t. Middle fork saluda". Containing one
hundred and sixty nine acres more or less, which Land was Granted to
Thomas Edwards Junr. by His Excellency James B Richardson bearing
date the fourth day of June one thousand Eight hundred four and
Bounded as followeth, Beginning on a Black Gum running S. 75
W. 50 c. 11. 81 links to a chestnut, thence N. 15. W. 20 ch. to a Black oak, near
a road, thence N. 85. E. 72 chs. to a Pine, thence S. 8. W. 24 ch. 25 links
