E. 3. 68. 50 to a Hick 34 on Dunbar thence N. W. 51. 50 to a stand 34 on Jerry hence S. W. 25. 12 to a Black O 34 cut down thence S. E. 21. 12. 6 on the new line of George Terry to the begining together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinances belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining unto the said premises to have and to hold the same as a above described unto the said Hewlet Sullivan his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & C to warrant and forever defend the same unto the said Hewlet his heirs or assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and against all other persons whom soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
