in the District of Greenville on the East side & on the waters of Reedy River
being part of land originally granted to Jesse Kirby containing Two Hundred and
Fifty Eight acres be the same more or less beginning at a dead stump 34 near
Wilkinson's & his corner thence North 35^o 50' to a Black Oak 34 on the flat Rock
thence N.E. 3^o 03.50 to a Hick 34 on Dunbars thence N.W 51^o 50' to a stand 34 on
Terry thence S.W 25^o 12' to a Black O 34 cut down thence S.E. 21. 12.6 on the new line of
George Terry to the beginning together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments and appertinances belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining unto the said premises to have and to hold the same as
as above described unto the said Hewlet Sullivan his heirs and assigns
forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors &c to warrant
and forever defend the same unto the said Hewlet his heirs or assigns
against myself my heirs and assigns and against all other persons whom
soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
