Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinences to the sd premises belonging or in any ^{wise} appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Henry Hall, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and assigns, to warrant and forever defend the above mentioned premises from one and my heirs and from any other persons or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof to the said Henry Hall and his heirs forever. E 35. 50 to a rock ^{3x} bounding on Hockerdys Bristers land thence S 83. E 22. 00 to a small black oak ^{3x} thence S 43 E 55. 00 to a stake ^{3x} bounding on the said Thompson Brister land thence N 83. W 64. 00 bounding on James Hollands land to the beginning together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinences to the said premises belonging, or in any ~~wise~~ ~~incident~~ or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Brister his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant & forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Samuel Brister his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to
