This indenture made this 26 of December 1806 between Thomas Mungy of the State of South Carolina & Greenville District of the one part and David Thomas of the said State and District aforesaid of the other part witnesseth, that the said Thomas Mungy for consideration of one hundred and fifty Dollars to him in hand paid by the s<sup>d</sup> David Thomas the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted and sold unto the said David Thomas a certain tract of land Situated in Greenville County and State aforesaid on Saluda River containing by computation one hundred acres more or less, beginning on a corner pine on W<sup>th</sup> Pogues line & thence with said line to a Stake on Bowens to William Gillilands corner pine and with s<sup>d</sup> line to a corner red oak & from thence unto the W<sup>th</sup> road & with s<sup>d</sup> road to a corner red oak & from thence to the beginning containing one hundred acres more or less, and the said Thomas Mungy will warrant & defend to him the said David Thomas his heirs all that tract of land within the above mentioned bounds as free and clear from me my heirs and from all and every person or persons whatsoever, in witness of the same I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day and date first above written.
