in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars to me in hand
paid by John Barrett of the district and State aforesaid the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted bargained sold convey-
ed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell
convey and confirm unto the said John Barrett his heirs and
assigns all my respective Right claim Interest and demand
of in or to part of a certain tract or parcel of Land situate in
Greenville District aforesaid on the head branches of Middle Tyger
River of which said part is computed at one hundred acres by the
same more or less, Beginning on a chestnut oak on Manns D. Toward
line running E. along said line to a Locust thence N. 45 Chains to a
W. oak on Michael Pruitts line thence along said Pruitts line
to a branch thence up the hollow to the Beginning corner of which
said part is taken from of a certain tract or parcel of Land containing
five hundred and sixty acres twenty six acres being granted to me the
said Benjamin Davis by a grant bearing date the fourth day of July
one thousand Eight hundred and fourteen. Whereof I do hereby
warrant and con defend the above mentioned premises unto the said
John Barrett his heirs and assigns forever, against me my heirs executors
or administrators to claim the same or any part thereof. In Witness
