bargain and sell a tract of land lying and being in Greenville District
Eocene River containing one hundred acres, be it more or less unto the said
J. Bridwell, it being a tract of land of H. Barne & A. Carney a survey,
Beginning on a black jack corner from thence along old Survey N. to red
oak corner from thence along said line W. to a Spanish oak corner
from thence to where is the line to said Hollands spring branch from thence
bounded on Barne line to a black jack or the beginning corner, so as
to conclude all woods water or any thing appertain thereto thence the said
B. Smith from his heirs Ex^t adm^r or aপign, doth warrant and defend
from any other person or persons forever claiming or touching said land
tract of land unto the said J. Bridwell his heirs Ex^t adm^r or aপign
forever warranting and defending bearing date in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen - it being the second
