Charleston in the State aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold  
and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and  
release unto the said John J. Bulow all those several planta-  
tions tract or parcels of land herein after mentioned lying &  
being in the district of Greenville and State aforesaid one tract  
or parcel of land lying and being on Guilden Creek of Enoree  
River containing four hundred and thirty two acres more or less  
Beginning on a chestnut running thence N<sup>o</sup> 10 E. 70 to a stake corner  
thence S<sup>o</sup> 80 E. 67 to a candle oak corner on a red oak thence a  
straight course along the said conditional line to a conditional  
corner on the original line on a post oak thence N<sup>o</sup> 80 W. by to the  
beginning - one other tract or parcel of land lying and being  
on Maple Creek of Reedy River containing two hundred sixteen  
acres more or less Beginning on a post oak running thence S<sup>o</sup> 11 W.
