Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Hugh Montgomery for and in consideration of debt or sum of one thousand dollars for the better securing the payment of the said sum of five hundred dollars to the said James Smith his certain attorney his heirs executors or assigns according to the condition of the bond or obligation aforesaid and also in consideration of the further sum of two cents to him the said Hugh Montgomery in hand paid by James Smith at and before the sealing and delivering this present the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and released unto the said James Smith all that tract of land whereon the said James Smith now lives situate being and lying in the district of Greenville and State aforesaid on the waters of South Tyger River containing two hundred and twelve acres more or less, which land was conveyed from William D. Thomas as referred to the Record of Greenville District will now fully and at large appear. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Smith his heirs and assigns forever. Provided always nevertheless, and it is the true intent and meaning of these parties to these presents that if the said Hugh Montgomery his heirs Executors admt. do well and truly pay or cause to be paid to the said James Smith his certain attorney his executors admt. or assigns the said sum of five hundred dollars as aforesaid according to the true intent & meaning of the said bond or obligation aforesaid and the conditions there under written. Then and in that case this present indenture & every clause and article therein contained shall be null & void any thing therein to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding, and it is agreed upon between the parties to these presents that unless default shall happen to be made in the payment of the said sum of Five hundred dollars, it shall and may be lawful for the said Hugh Montgomery peaceably and quietly to occupy possess & enjoy all and singular the premises above mentioned and every part thereof and receive the rents issues and profits thereof.
