King do hereby bind myself my heirs &c to warrant the said negro man Jacob to the said John Blasingame his heirs and assigns forever - Witness my hand this Sixth day of November 1815 - Signed Seal & delivered in the presence of

Know all men by these presents that we James Benjamin Harrison of Greenville District and State aforesaid in consideration of Seven hundred and fifty dollars to us paid by Joshua Hawkins of district and State aforesaid have granted bargained and sold a certain tract of land lying on the East Side of Reedy River being a part of a tract of land laid out to Charles Benson and part of a tract laid out to John Can and a part of a tract laid out to John Harrison containing in the whole two hundred and fifty acres more or less, and hath such boundaries as will now be mentioned beginning on a maple at the ford of Reedy River and thence down the main stream to Robert Duncans maple corner thence on Easterly Course a conditional line to Charles Bensons old original line thence up the said line to a post oak corner then taking John Harrisons old line to a hickory corner thence a westerly course to a perforation on the road then down the road to the beginning maple with all and singular the rights more or less hereunto and appertinances, to the said premises belonging in any wise incident or appertaining to the said Joshua Hawkins his heirs or assigns & I do bind myself my heirs Exors. and assigns to forever warrant and defend the above mentioned premises unto the said Joshua Hawkins his heirs and assigns forever against the claim of me or my heirs or any other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, in witness whereof I have
