


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Seaborn land, Beginning at a Stake on the trail road, then N. 18 W. 17.50 to a

 the said premises with their appurtenances since the seizure by me made by virtue  
 of the said "order of Court" before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue  
 and purchased by Robert Alexander of the district of Greenville for the sum of five  
 hundred and eighty dollars, that price or sum being the highest sum that was bid  
 therefor: NOW know ye that I the said Thomas Payne Sheriff aforesaid by virtue  
 of the said "order of Court" to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the  
 Statute in such case made and provided, and for and in consideration of the said sum  
 of five hundred and eighty dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said  
 Robert Alexander the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have  
 granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the  
 said Robert Alexander his heirs and assigns for ever the said tract piece and parcel of  
 land with its appurtenances, and all the estate right title and interest which the said  
 James Seaborn or his heirs of right had of in and to the same: To have & to hold  
 the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said  
 Robert Alexander his heirs and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as  
 I the said Thomas Payne might, could or ought to grant bargain & sell  
 the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid & the said "order of Court" or otherwise.

 I George Brooks of the State and district aforesaid in consideration of the sum of  
 four hundred dollars to me paid by Daniel Ford of the said State & district aforesaid  
 have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bar-  
 gain sell and release unto the said Daniel Ford, part of a tract of land that  
 was originally granted to Mary Burns for 315 acres by a grant bearing date  
 the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1785 Recorded in Grant book EEE page 565 then conveyed  
 to George Brooks now from said Brooks to said Ford, part of the tract situated  
 in the State and district aforesaid, on the Waters of Lady River, Beginning at  
 a Red Oak thence running N. 50 W. 28 to a Red Oak 34 thence S 55 W. 50 to a Stake  
 then N. 75 E 19.50 to a Stake 34 thence S 55 E 38.50 to a Stake 34, thence S 46 E  
 39 to a Red Oak 34 thence N 55 E. 19.50 to an ash on the Cedar Shoal branch  
 up the meanders of said branch about 50 to a Stake 34 N. 3 W. 21 to the beginning  
 Red Oak 34 Including Two hundred acres of land (to the same more or less)
