beds furniture & cattle to them the said Jos. and John S Sullivan
their heirs and assigns forever Provided never the less and it is
Expressly understood that if the said Wm Gunnell, his
heirs Executors or administrators shall and does well and truly
pay or cause to be paid unto the said Jos. & John S Sullivan
their heirs or assigns the said promissory note of one hundred
