Greenwich District & State of South Carolina in consideration of
the love and affection which I have & bear unto my
beloved daughter Sarah Loftis, of the State of South Carolina
Spartanburgh District and also for divers other good causes and
Considerations. - me the said Job Loftis herunto moving have given
Granted and confirmed, and by these presents do give grant and
Confirm unto the said Sarah Loftis all and singular my slaves, &
have put her in possession of them by delivering them to her by
name Harriet and her child, Silva at the time of sealing and
delivering of these presents with the exception of me the said
Job Loftis having the use benefit & profits of their labour
during my life time then at the expiration of my life time
the said Sarah Loftis to have and to hold all and singular
the increase, benefits, profits, advantages & incomes of the above
mentioned negroes in whatsoever possession they may be found unto
the said Sarah Loftis her Executors, administrators and assigns unto
the only proper use and behoof of the said Sarah Loftis, agai
not me the said Job Loftis my heirs Executors administrators & assigns
and all and every person or persons whatsoever shall
and with warrant and forever defend by these presents the
above mentioned negroes unto the said Sarah Loftis In
witness whereof I have herunto set my hand & affixed my
seal this eight day of April one thousand eight hundred
and twenty three
