tion of the sum of twelve hundred dollars to me in
hand paid by Wilson Bobb of the District and State aforesaid,
have granted bargained sold and released and by these
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
Wilson Bobb all that plantation or tract of land lying
in the District aforesaid on the waters of the Grove Creek
being part of Land belonging to James Seabourn Deas
beginning at a Red oak 3x near David Battan on the trail Road
thence N 46° W 59.50 to a dead black Oak 3x thence S 75° W 26.50
to a white oak Slump 3x thence up the meanders of the branch
to a maple 3x thence S 70 E 70 to a Stake 3x on the trail Road
thence with the meanders of S. Road to the beginning containing
two hundred and eighty two acres be the same as one acre.
Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditament,
and appurtenances to the sd premises belonging or in any wise
incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singu-
lar the premises before mentioned unto the said Wilson Bobb his
his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs & executors
and admr. to warrant and forever defend all and singular the sd premises unto
the sd Wilson Bobb his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and
against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
