



State of South Carolina. I know all men by these presents
 that J. Francis Adams of the District of Greenville and State of South
 Carolina in Consideration of the sum of four hundred Dollars to me
 in hand paid by George Mitchel of the District and State aforesaid
 - said have granted bargained sold and released and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said George
 Mitchel part of a tract or parcel of land lying and being in
 the District aforesaid on the head of the sink hole fork of Tyger River
 Beginning at chestnut and running thence north eighty chain to a
 chestnut thence west to the head of a branch west of where —
 Thomas Bowe now lives running thence south with said branch
 to Michael Prewets line thence East and to follow said line with its
 different courses until it intersects with Richard Ward line thence on
 Ward line to the River thence down the River to the mouth of a
 branch thence due south until it crosses the original line on Tutt's
 mountain thence east to the begining corner containing by estima-
 tion four hundred acres be the same more or less the same
 being part of a tract of land granted to Johnman Eddon
 bearing date the seventh of May seventeen hundred and eighty seven
 together with all and singular the Rights, member hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the above mentioned premises belonging
 or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular
 - or the premises before mentioned unto the said George Mitchel
 and his here by bind myself my heirs executors or administrators
 to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
 unto the said George Mitchel his heirs and assigns for ever again
 - st me and my heirs and against every person or persons whom
 - ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part the
 - euf I'm witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 this second day of October one thousand eight hundred and twenty one
