Pollard & signed by his Excellency Joseph Alston on the 17<sup>th</sup> Nov 1814 & laid out as follows begining on a Stake corner on Thompson Dickersons line thence N. 65° W. to a hickey 3x. thence S. 30° E. 16. to a Rd. 0.3x. on William bottoms line thence a long bottom, line S. 90° W. 15. 20. to a chestnut 3x. thence S. 30° E. 39. 20 to Thompson Dickerson 3x. thence N.E. a long sd Dickersons line the beginning in abiding in Cluding one hundred and seventy five acres more or less together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Dean his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs & executors to warrant & forever defend the same unto John Dean his heirs & assigns against my self & every other Person or Persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have set my hand & seal this 26 April 1823.
