Know all men by these presents that J. Polly Sinkins of Greenville  
district & State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one  
thousand and fifty dollars to me paid by William Langford of the State  
and district aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
William Langford a plantation or tract of land lying & being situate  
in the District of Greenville on the northern side of a road that leads  
from said Sinkins Mill to Captain Thomas Springfield and on the  
South side of the Enore River beginning on a red oak corner on the  
side of the said Road at the head of a small valley thence north-  
-wardly a conditional line to a Speck onyx & an Samuel Stiles line  
thence westwardly on an open line binding on said Stiles line to  
Black Jack & thence southwardly on Stiles & Elisha Greens line  
to a red oak & on the said Road that leads from said Capt  
Thomas Springfield to said Polly Sinkins Mill on the Enore River  
thence down the said Road to the head of the Valley the beginning  
Corner stand in to a stake & thence to the beginning all together  
supposed to contain one hundred acres be the same more or  
less together with all and singular the Rights manors & appurte-  
-nances and appertenance, to the said premises, belonging or in any
