I know all men by these presents that J. Polly Sinking of Greenville district & State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand and fifty dollars to me paid by William Langford of the State and district aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Langford a plantation or tract of land lying & being situated in the District of Greenville on the northern side of a road that leads from said Sinking Mill to Captain Thomas Springfield and on the south side of the Enore River beginning on a red oak corner on the side of the said Road at the head of a small valley thence northwardly a conditional line to a stake 3x. on Samuel Stiles line thence westwardly on an open line binding on said stake line to Black Jack 3x. thence southwardly on Stiles & Elisha Green line to a red oak 3x. on the said road that leads from said Capt Thomas Springfield to said Rolla Sinking Mill on the Enore River thence down the said Road to the head of the Valley thence beginning corner stand in to a stake 3x. thence to the beginning as together specified to contain one hundred acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the Rights manors hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
