members heretofore and appurtenances to have and to hold
all and singular the premises mentioned unto the said Jacob Linderman
his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my
my heirs and assigns and administrators to warrant and forever

defend all and singular the part or parcel of Land unto the
said Jacob Linderman his heirs and assigns against myself
my heirs and assigns and all and every other person or persons
what ever in Witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and
Seal this 12 day of 1821
