of the State of Georgia and county of Franklin have
this day bargained and sold unto Anna Woodson of the
State of South Carolina and Greenville District a certain
tract or parcel of land lying and being in the State and
District and State aforesaid on both sides of Mountain
Creek of Saluda River containing by computation one
Hundred and forty two acres be the same more or less for the
Sum of one hundred and forty two dollars to me in hand
paid by the said Anna Woodson the receipt whereof is
herely acknowledged it being a part of a tract of land
granted to William Wood on the first day of may one thousand
and seven hundred and eighty six beginning on a red oak
and running S 86 E 16 chain to a tight wood Stake corner an
Dealer line thence S 10 E 91 chain to Wriah Statens Hickory corner
on said line thence a long said Statens line a cross mountain
Creek to his Stake corner thence on James Leumpton line to
the West line of the Original survey of said Wood thence N 4
E to the beginning corner which said tract a parcel of land
Have granted bargained and sold unto the said Anna
Woodson & her heirs for ever and I the said Boley banner
will for ever warrant and defend the Right of said land
for and against myself my heirs and Executors and admin-
istrators unto the said Anna Woodson her heirs and assigns
for ever In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this fourth day of November in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and four-
teen signed sealed and delivered in presence of us
George Thomason, Jane Thomason, Boley banner Seal
South Carolina } Personally came George Thomason before me
Greenville District } and made oath that he saw Boley banner
sign seal and deliver the within and of conveyance for
the use and purpose within mentioned and that
Jane Thomason was a subscribing witness with him
Self at the same time sworn to and subscribed
this 25 of November 1814 before me
