I know all men by present that I John Gaven of
Grunville District for and in consideration of the sum
of Five Thousand dollars to me in hand paid by Joe
-meah Cleveland of the same district have granted
bargained sold and released, and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joe
-meah Cleveland all that parcel plantation or
tract of land situate in the district aforesaid
on both sides of the middle fork of Saluda River
Containing by estimation two thousand acres, more or
less including four hundred acres granted to John
Gaven on the 15th day of October 1784. Except a small
part conveyed to Jepse Mayfield five hundred and
fifty three acres granted to the said John Gaven on
the 4 day of February 1793. Eight hundred and twenty
acres granted to John Gaven on the 30 day of January
1814. except a bout twenty acres more or less agreed to
be sold to John Bates, also one hundred and fifty acres
Granted to John Burns on the first day of January
1787 by him conveyed to John Gaven by deed by the
latter to my self also two hundred acres granted to John
Geffers by whom it was conveyed to James Gaven and
by him to Buckley Blasingame, and by him to my self
also ninety nine acres conveyed to me by Jepse Mayfield
by deed bearing date the 10th day of April 1815 also one hundred
and forty eight acres of land on the south side of the
same River being part of a tract originally granted
to George Woolf by him divided to David Grogan
and by him conveyed to my self by deed bearing
date the 1st day of March 1821. each of the said tracts
