 These presents that I, John H. Harrison, of the state and District  
 Aforesaid for the full sum of four hundred dollars, paid to  
 Me by Charles Garrison of the same state and District, have  
 granted bargained, sold & released and by these presents do  
 Grant bargain sell & release unto the said Charles Garrison a tract  
 or parcel of land containing two hundred & thirty nine acres,  
 More or less originally granted to James Harrison & Ambrose  
 Blackburn, on this 5<sup>th</sup> March 1789, by Tho. Pinkney then  
 Gov. bounded S. W. & S. E. on Nathan Waddell's land N. E. on said  
 Garrison's Land, N. W. & S. W. on Maxwell's land being a part of the  
 original survey on waters of Saluda River in said District and in  
 actual possession of said Garrison since the 12<sup>th</sup> of March 1816  
 Being the time of the purchase to have and to hold the premises  
 as described forever, against me & my heirs or assigns and against  
 all persons claiming the same or any part thereof, to  
 the proper use, & behoof of the said Garrison his heirs, assigns,  
 Executors and administrators forever, I witness where to I set my  
 hand and affix my seal this tenth day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1823, and  
 annex a plat of the premises signed sealed & delivered in presen  
 ce of John Wilson }  
 Hugh Wilson. }
