I know all men by these presents that I Thomas Brasher  
of the said State & District for the sum of five hundred dollars  
paid to me by Aquilla Brasher, of the same place have  
Granted Bargained sold and released and by these prece-  
nts do grant bargain sell & release unto the Aquilla Brasher  
his heirs and assigns all that parcel or tract of land lying  
and being in the said State and district on the head branch  
of Cripple Creek waters of Ruddy river wherein the  
said Aquilla now lies containing one hundred and  
thirty acres less the same more or less beginning at  
Part Oak 3X thence N 65 W 30 to a Stake thence N 4 E  
42 to a Stake thence S 86 E 30 to a Spanish Oak sapling on the  
old white line thence with the same S 24 W 42 to the begining  
To have & to hold the premises as aforesaid described unto  
the said Aquilla Brasher his heirs and assigns for ever  
Together with all and singular the rights manors her-  
editaments & appurtenances to the same belonging or in  
any wise incident or appertaining and I do hereby bind  
my self my heirs Executors &c to warrant and for ever  
defend the said premises unto the said Aquilla Brasher  
his heirs and assigns against my self & mine and  
against every other person a person whom soever I am witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my  
seal this 19 day of July one thousand eight hundred  
and twenty signed sealed & delivered in the presence  
of Eli Baldwin, Jedidiah Cook, <sup>his</sup> Thomas <sup>his</sup> Brasher <sup>his</sup>  
South Carolina. Personally came before me Eli Baldwin —  
Greenville District being duly sworn and on oath that he saw  
Thomas Brasher sign seal and deliver the within deed  
of conveyance to Aquilla Brasher for the use and purpose  
without question and that he saw Jedidiah Cook  
sign his name with himself as a subscriber thereto,  
sworn to and subscribed the 19 day of July 1820
