 That I McVay Armstrong for and in consideration of the sum of
 Four hundred dollars to me paid have bargained granted and sold
 And by these presents do bargain sell and release unto James Farr,
 All that tract or parcel of Land whereon George Bradley late
 Dec^d of this District liv^d in his life time lying on Armstrongs
 Creek and bounded as follows, beginning on a Gum saplin on the
 East Bank of Armstrongs Creek thence along a fence to a red
 oak saplin thence a straight line to a red oak near William Mos-
 ting original line, thence along said line to a post oak corner
 Thence said line to a conditional line between George Bradley
 And Sidence Bradley to Armstrongs Creek thence a condition-
 al line between George Bradley and Abraham Bradley to a
 conditional line between Abraham Bradley and James Bruce
 thence along said line to a conditional line between George Brad-
 ley and Thomas Hooper thence said line to a conditional line
 between George Bradley and George Evans thence said line to a
 Maple on the west bank of Armstrongs Creek thence to the
 beginning containing one hundred and fifty acres, be the same
 More or less according to the above boundaries together with
 All and singular the rights members and hereditaments to
 The said premises belonging or in anywise appertaining to
 The same unto the said James Farr his heirs and assigns
 forever, in witness where of I have hereunto subscribed my
 Name and affixed my seal this 3rd day of May 1824 signed
 Seal and delivered in presence of
 J. H. Goodlett Abraham Spencer, McVay ^{his} Armstrong
 South Carolina, Personally appeared Abraham ^{mark} Spencer
 Greenville District before me the subscribing Justice and after
 being duly sworn according to law sayeth on his oath that
 He saw McVay Armstrong sign the within deed for the
 purposes within mentioned and that he saw John H. Goodlett
 subscribe his name as a witness together with his self to the
 same sworn to before me this 3rd May 1824
