 on the original line to a Hickory corner from thence to the begin-  
 ning, with all and singular the rights, members heredita-  
 ments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
 or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold  
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
 Elijah Pike his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind  
 My self, my heirs Executors administrators or assigns to -
