Released, and by these presents do, grant bargain sell and release  
unto the said Doc: Thomas G. Walker, one certain Lot. of Land sit-  
uate lying and being in the village of Pleasantburg, at Greenville  
Court House in the State of South Carolina Known and distinguis-  
hed in the Plan or Chart of the said village by the number twenty,
