


sideration of the sum of five hundred dollars paid by
Newton Bramblett have sold and by these presents do

on the North side of Rudy River containing one
hundred acres more or less being laid out to the
said Newton Bramblett as follows Beginning on
a stake 3x near Honey Creek thence S. 60. W. to 3x.
thence S. 30^E. to conditional Po 3x. a gued on thence
a westwardly course and condescendal line
