 & By these presents do grant bargain sell & Release unto
 the said Elliott Clarardy all that Tract or parcel of Land
 supposed to contain two hundred acres be the same more
 or less on the South fork of Enoree River a part of said tract
 originally granted to Obediah Hooper, another part to
 Robert Prince Beginning at a Poplar corner made by Sam-
 uel Gordon near the Cattail Branch thence down the
 Meadow to a post oak on Henry Sangford's line or Land
 thence straight to the River thence down the different
 meanders of the River to said Sangford's lower line thence
 to a Pine corner on Isaac Semons land thence to a Red
 oak on Thomas Springfields Land thence to a Spanish oak
 on said Springfields Land thence to a Pine corner of the
 Tract originally granted to Robert Prince on the said
 Springfields Land thence south 65. W. to a Hickory on
 James Springfields Land thence to a White oak corner
 on the Bank of the River near Robert Bensons old Brid-
 ge thence down the different meanders of said River
 to original line of Robert Prince thence with said line
 to the Poplar corner corner the Beginning conveyed to James
 Calhoun by John P. Bunson & young Pool as for Reference
