

South Carolina Memorandum That on this fifteen  
Greenville County the day of march 1800 John Brasher  
Came Before me and made oath that he was present  
And did see Henry Brasher sign seal deliver and  
acknowledge the within deed to the within named  
Thomas Brasher for the use and purpose within  
mentioned and did also see Aquilla Brasher sign  
as a witness to the same with him self sworn the  
Date above written Before me

I John Gowen of Greenville District & State aforesaid  
For & in the Consideration of the Sum of Sixty five  
Dollars to me paid by John Bates of said district have  
Granted bargained & sold & by these presents do Grant  
Bargain sell & Release unto the said John Bates a  
Certain parcel of Land laying in said District on  
on the branches of the middle fork of Saluda River,  
The same being Granted to Joseph Johnson Reference  
Being had to the grant will give all the corners & Corners  
That is to say one hundred & forty two acres more or  
less included in said Grant Twenty acres, Except  
ed which were sold out of said Grant by Joseph Johnson  
To J. H. Waldrif & made up to the said J. Bates by ad-  
ding Twenty Twenty acres to his lower line which  
Will be a condition all line made between said Bates &  
premises above land laid off by Joseph Macquartain  
& Thomas Harkins & Run as follows Red oak the big-  
inning corner thence along said line towards =
