

Me in hand paid by Peter Shockley the Receipt of  
 which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained-  
 sold, Granted, and Released unto said Peter Shock-  
 ley a certain tract or parcel of land containing  
 Fifty five acres - Being a part of a tract of land  
 originally surveyed for Paul Abner and Granted  
 To Henry Hughs February 5<sup>th</sup> 1787 lying in  
 The State and district aforesaid on Brushy Creek of  
 Emorie River and lying on the S. E. side of a parcel  
 of land of the same survey which I sold to Lewis  
 Suddith and Beginning at a Stake or Post oak-  
 corner on the south Boundary of Lewis Suddiths  
 Land, and thence Running S. 67. E 25 chains to a Stake  
 corner, at Mr. Moores Land, or land Granted to John-  
 Walker, thence N. 10 W. 16 chains 50 links, to a Red  
 oak corner, thence N 55. E 11 chains 50 links, to a post  
 oak corner, at land Granted to Moser Kemp and  
 now owned by George Popp, thence N. 40 W. 19 chains  
 25 links with said Moser Kemps Grant to a Pine  
 corner, thence S. 35 W 34 chains 90 links, with  
 Lewis Suddiths line to the beginning corner:-

 eration of the above mentioned sum of money  
 which has been paid to me by said Shockley, I  
 Building Suddith do Grant Sell, and Release <sup>the</sup>  
 Above mentioned tract of land to Peter Shockley

 Belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining  
 To have and to hold all and singular the said -  
 Premises before mentioned unto said Peter Shockley  
 his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my  
 self my heirs, Executors and administrators, &c. to war-  
 rant and forever defend all and singular the said  
 Premises unto the said Peter Shockley his heirs
