 unto the said Micajah J. Smith two tracts of land lying
 & being in Greenville District on both sides of the middle
 Fork of Saluda River and a Branch of said River way
 one tract containing one hundred & fifty acres granted
 to Thomas Wood the third of April one thousand seven
 hundred & eighty six also one other tract granted
 to David Norris containing one hundred and eighty
 acres by patent bearing date the fifth of January
 1801 containing in the whole three hundred & thirty
 acres more or less, Reference being had to said Grants
 Will give all the Corners & Courses of said Land Together
 with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments
 and appurtenances there unto belonging or in any wise
 appertaining to have and to hold, all and singular
 The Land and premises above mentioned including
 all the houses & plantation when on the said Isaac Ford
 now lives, unto the said Micajah J. Smith his heirs &
 assigns forever and I do here by Bind my self my heirs
 Executors and administrators to warrant and forever
 defend unto the said Micajah J. Smith his heirs and
