 Witnesseth that the S^d J. A. Pollard doth leave in the hands of
 the S^d Benj^r Pollard two Negro boys one named Alexander
 a bought fifteen years old the other named Henry a
 Bought thirteen years of age which negroes the S^d Benj^r
 amin Pollard is to have the labour of during his & my
 Mothers life time if I continue to live in the afore said
 District but if I should be a bought to remove from
 the district then the afore said Negroes to be given
 up to the said J. A. Pollard or his assigner which Negroes
 I the said Benj^r Pollard Senr. acknowledges to be the
 Property of the afore said J. A. Pollard In witness where
 of we have set our hands & seals this 18th March 1822
