 by their presents, that J. Hewlet Sullivan Jun. of the state and  
 District aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of seven =  
 hundred and fifty dollars, to me in hand paid by Saml.  
 Moore of the same place have granted, bargained, sold and  
 Released and by their presents do grant, bargain, sell and release  
 unto the said Saml. Moore two plantations or tracts of land  
 the first containing, one hundred and eighty five acres, more  
 or less, it being a part of a tract of land originally granted to  
 Maximilian Coover by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney  
 Esq. Governor, for the time being, dated 5<sup>th</sup> March one thousand  
 Seven hundred and Eighty seven lying and being in the State  
 and district aforesaid, on the waters of the Rudy Fork, of Rudy  
 River, Beginning on a Post oak corner thence S. 50° W. 50 ch. to  
 Stake x on or near Russell's land. near Brewers, thence N  
 85° W. 33 ch. to a Stake x on part of the same tract thence  
 N 6° W 50 ch. to a Stake in Brewers field thence S 85° E 41 ch.  
 to the beginning this said tract conveyed by James Smith to  
 said Hewlet Sullivan Jun. now by him to the said Saml. =  
 Moore, the other tract in the aforesaid State and district,  
 adjoining the above mentioned tract on said waters con-  
 taining Eighty acres, more or less, granted to John Brewer,  
 on the fourth of Janry. one thousand Eight hundred and  
 Thirteen lies in grant Book No. of page 308 Beginning on  
 a post 3x near the road thence S. 88° W. 17 ch. to Stake 3x  
 thence S. 6° E 1 ch. to crooked Spanish oak 3x thence N.
