 presents do bargain sell release and confirm unto the  
 said Peter Garrison, his heirs and assigns forever, all that  
 Tract or parcel of land, containing three hundred & forty three  
 acres, more or less, situated lying and being in the aforesaid  
 State & District on a small Branch of the Golden Grove of  
 Saluda River, laid out to the said Garrison, as follows, Begin-  
 ning at a Holly on the Branch thence S. 43. E 10. 66. Ch-  
 ins. to a chum nut thence S. 30. E 15. 20 chains to a White
