State of South Carolina Greenville District, know all men  
By these presents that I William McCullough of Greenville-  
District in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the natu-  
ral love and affection which I have to my nephew William  
McCullough of the State of Pennsylvania Lancaster County  
and I the Said William McCullough sen<sup>r</sup>. do promise to pay  
to William McCullough Jun<sup>r</sup>. the sum of three hundred dollars  
in Real property at the valuation of man or the sum of  
three hundred to be paid in cash to William McCullough Jr.  
which I do bind myself my heirs Executors, and adm<sup>r</sup>s to  
warrant & for ever defend the same witness my hand &  
Seal this 9<sup>th</sup> day of June 1825 Wm. McCullough Seal

N.B the above property mentioned I do promise to pay to  
William McCullough Jun<sup>r</sup>. or his heirs at their arrival in  
the State of South Carolina witness my hand & seal
