 Together with all and singular the rights, members, Hereditaments and  
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging in any wise incident  
 or pertaining to them and to hold all and singular the pre-  
 mises be fore mentioned unto the said John Baker his heirs and  
 assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors  
 and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend  
 all and singular the said premises unto the said John  
 Baker his heirs and assigns against myself and  
 my heirs and against every other person
