I know all men by these presents that whereas John Baker  
of the State and district aforesaid was in his life time and at the time  
of his death seized and possessed in fee simple of eight hundred  
and forty eight Acres of Land lying in the State and district  
aforesaid, and whereas the said John Baker left four legatees  
besides the widow to divide his Estate among that is Elizabeth  
Peden the wife of Samuel Peden, Linsey A. Baker, Saml  
H. Baker and John W. Baker which legatees being all  
of age have agreed to divide the real Estate and person-  
al Estate property among them selves by mutual  
consent. Samuel Peden and his wife has received their  
~~full~~ distributive share of said Estate in personal property  
which they are fully satisfied with and left the real Estate  
to be divided between the other three that is Linsey A. Baker  
Samuel H. Baker and John W. Baker now we Linsey A. Baker  
and John W. Baker in consideration of having little made  
to us by the other legatees to our party of the said land  
doth by convey and release and by these presents  
do release and convey to Samuel H. Baker the plantation  
where he now lives containing three hundred and twenty
