The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Richard Harrison of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of three thousand dollars, to me Paid by Richard Gantt, of the same district in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and Released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and Release, unto the said Richard Gantt, all plantation tract and parcel of land, containing five hundred and ninety two acres more or less situate lying and being in the district aforesaid on the waters of Saluda River, and the Golden Grove creek and having the following lines courses and boundaries  
 Beginning on a red oak on the East side of the main Road to Greenville C. h. running thence East 34 chains with crowford's late line to a stake corner thence N. 35 chains with Hall's line to a pine corner thence N. 70. E. 4 chains to a stake corner,
