Alexander administrators of the Estate of David Peden dec'd late of  
the State and District aforesaid in conformity with an order  
of the Court of Common Pleas for said District In consider-  
-ation of six hundred dollars to us paid by John Mc D. Harris-  
-son of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargained  
& sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release  
to the said John Mc D. Harrison a certain tract or parcel of land  
containing three hundred acres situate in State and District a-  
foresaid lying on the waters of Raysburns Creek being a part of a  
tract of land containing nine hundred & ten acres originally granted  
to David Peden by his Excellency Charles Pinckney the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March  
1792 Beginning and Past Cakes & Running thence S. 26.50 to a forked red oak  
thence N. 50 E 105 to a Pine & Stake & thence N. 26.50 to a Stake & thence  
S 50 W 105 to the beginning Together with all and singular the Right & mem-  
bers hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any  
wise incident or appertaining To Have and to Hold all & singular the prem-  
-ises before mentioned unto the sd John Mc D. Harrison his heirs and assigns  
for ever and we do hereby bind our selves as administrators of the  
Estate of David Peden Dec'd to warrant & for ever defend & singular  
the said premises unto the said John Mc D. Harrison his heirs and  
assigns against our selves & the Heirs of David Peden Dec'd lawfully  
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof with in our hands  
and seals this third day of January in the year of our Lord eighteen  
hundred and twenty five & in the forty eight year of the American Independ-  
ency witness present
