dollars to me in hand paid by Benjamin Kilgore of the  
State and District aforesaid have granted bargained  
and sold and by these presents do grant bargain  
and sell unto the said Benjamin Kilgore two certain  
tracts or parcels of land lying in Gunville District on  
the South side of Golden Creek Water of Enoree River  
One tract of one hundred and four acres that was  
granted to William Vaughn from said Vaughn to  
to Alexander Dacus from said Dacus to William Obriant  
from William Obriant to Eli Balding from said Bal-  
ding to William Obriant the other tract was granted  
by patent to Benjamin Levil the 17 day of May 1789 and  
conveyed from said Benjamin Levil to William Mitz-  
erson from said Mitzerson to William Obriant the  
two tracts conveyed from William Obriant to the open  
phelus Cannon beginning at a Post oak corner 3x  
running N. 19 chains on John Butters land to a red oak  
3x thence N. 38 E 17 chains & twenty five links to a Stake
