

 the District and State aforesaid, have granted bargained  
 and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
 and release unto Joseph P. Labruce, of the same district  
 and State, for and in consideration of the sum of -  
 Ten Dollars to me in hand paid the receipt where of is  
 Hereby acknowledged a certain tract or piece of land  
 in Greenville District bounded as follows, Beginning on  
 a Dogwood one of the corners of a tract sold the said  
 Labruce, by Amasa Spencer, and on Vickers line thence  
 Running along said line to a pine in the old field  
 thence crossing a branch to a poplar mark & III being the  
 West South westerly corner of the aforesaid tract  
 sold by a Spencer, aforesaid thence recrossing the  
 Branch to a Hedgerow, along the same to the
