 that I John Mahaffey Senior of Greenville District and
 State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of
 three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by John
 Mahaffey Junior of the same State and district have
 granted bargained sold and by these presents do
 grant bargain sell and release unto the sd John
 Mahaffey Junr all that tract or plantation of
 land containing one hundred and twenty acres
 it being a part of a tract of one thousand
 acres originally granted to Benjamin Kilgore
 by Patten bearing date the 3rd day of Sept 1792
 situate in Greenville District and State aforesaid including
 the plantation whereon Newman Wilson for
 many years otherwise when the said John Mahaffey
 Junr now lives Beginning on a Red Oak corner a dividing
 corner made between Wm Butler & Penwell Wood
 and runs N. 23. E. 42. to a stake 37 then on Robert Rutledge
 line on sd line N.E. 10 to a red Oak then S. 64. E. 17. 50 to a red
 Oak 37 then S. 30 W. 15 then S. 31. W. 21 then S. 30 W. 19 to a post
 Oak 3x then N. 45. W. 22 to the beginning which includes
 the full land to be conveyed together with all and singular
 the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereto belonging or any wise incident or
 appertaining thereto and I do hereby bind my self
 and heirs executors &c to warrant and forever defend
 all and singular the premises above mentioned unto
 the said John Mahaffey for his heirs executors &c forever &
 against my self my heirs executors and assigns and against
 every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claim
 ing the same or any part thereof witness my hand
 and seal this 17th day of May 1821. ^{Seal}
