Know all men by presents that I Hugh Clement  
of the State aforesaid and of Pendleton for and  
in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars  
to me in hand paid by Tucker Woodson of the  
and district aforesaid have granted bargained  
sold and released unto the said Tucker Woodson  
a certain plantation and tract of land containing  
one hundred and thirty one acres more or less it  
being part of a tract originally granted to James  
More for two hundred and nine acres dated  
the third day of September 1787 and recorded in  
Granted Book U. U. U. page 28 lying and being  
in Greenville District on the north side of Saluda  
River Beginning at a poplar on the River 3X running  
N. 80 E 35 ch to a Po. & 3. thence S. 10 E. 25 ch to a B. oak & joining  
Ezekiel Vincent, and thence a straight line to the Head  
of the second branch where Pierce ford thence down  
the meander of said branch joining John Clark to the  
River thence up the meander of the River to the beginning  
together with all and singular the rights, members, heredi-  
-taments, and appurtenances to the said premises —  
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to  
have ~~had~~ to hold all and singular the premises —  
before mentioned unto the said Tucker Woodson  
his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind  
myself my heirs executors to warrant and forever  
defend all and singular the premises unto the said  
Tucker Woodson his heirs and assigns against myself and  
my heirs and against every person whosoever lawfully  
coming or to claim the same or any part thereof —  
Witness my hand and seal this 4 day of Sept one thousand  
and eight hundred and seventeen and in the forty-second  
year of the Independence of the United States of America  
Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of  
William Berry, Benj Matherne, Hugh Clement Seal,  
South Carolina
