 by Joseph McCullough of the state and district aforesaid
 hath granted, bargained, sold and released and by these
 presents doth grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Joseph
 McCullough, a certain tract or parcel of land situate and
 lying on the North side of Saluda River containing fifty
 One acre more or less being part of a tract originally
 granted to John Martin then conveyed to William Hallbrook
 then to James Rags. thence to Loomy Rags. thence to Le an and
 Coker thence to Hudson Berry and now to the said Joseph McC
 ullough. Beginning at a P.O. joining Alexander's land and
 running N. 35 E 77 joining to McCullough, line to Hickory
 thence S 65 W. 6. to Hickory thence N. 87 W. 69. 25 to Stake thence N. 17 E
 11. 25 to the beginning together with all and singular the rights
 members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
 premises belonging or in any case incident or pertaining
 to have and to hold all and singular the said premises
 before mentioned unto the said Joseph McCullough his
 heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my
 heirs Executors Administrators to warrant and for ever defend
 all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph
 McCullough his heirs and assigns against myself and
 my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof also binding with all
 right title claim and interest that I may or have had to twenty
 seven acres that W. H. L. Williams bought of Drewry and William
