 for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and twenty five Dollars to
 me in hand paid by Timothy H. Keeler of the District and State aforesaid
 have granted bargained and sold unto the said T. H. Keeler a tract or parcel
 of Land supposed to contain one hundred Acres be the same more or less
 lying on both sides of the Buncombe Road commencing on a poplar on the Grassy
 branch thence N 25 Chains 50 links to a Stake Corner on Suche, line thence with
 said line S 50° W 13.50 to a pine thence N 19 Chains to a post Oak thence
 N 63° W 11 Ch 50 Lin. to a Spanish Oak thence Turpin's Corner, thence
 S 26° W 23 to a Hickory thence a Strail line across the Buncombe Road to
 a Stake by a Oak. From on Grassy Branch thence down said Branch
 to the Beginning poplar corner together with all & Singular the Rights
 members hereditaments & appurtenances to the same belong now or here
 after incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the
 premises above mentioned unto the said T. H. Keeler his heirs and assigns
 forever and further I do bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators
 to warrant and forever defende all and singular the said premises
 unto the said T. H. Keeler to his heirs and assigns and against myself
 & my heirs or any other person or persons lawfully claiming the same
 or any part thereof Witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand
 & seal this 2nd day October 1835, and in the 14th year of the United
 States of America Independence
