fully appear from the will of my Father William McLanahan and two deeds
one from Robinson and the other from Borden lying in Greenville district on
the West side of Reedy River containing one thousand acres more or less where
and I warrant and defend from myself my heirs or assigns or any other person
fully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof
I do set my hand and seal this 7th day of November 1835
