 a post Oak on Burys line thence N 80 E 20 to the Creek thence down the
 same with its Meanders to the beginning being part of four several tracts
 Granted to John & Helwick William Neal Stephen Ford & Oliver Cockburn
 to have and to hold all & singular the premises above described together
 with the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the same belong-
 ing or appertaining to the said Joseph Wham his heirs & assigns forever &
 I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors &c. to warrant and defend
 the same as above described to the said Wham & his against myself
 and mine and against all other person or persons lawfully claiming
 the same or any part thereof he testifies of which I have subscribed
