 Land containing one hundred and ninety acres more or less situated  
 in Greenville district lying on Saluda River beginning on a Pine  
 = 3x N 70 E 2- to a white Oak 3x thence N 63 E 62.50 to a Stake 3x thence S 6 E  
 = 39 to a Hickory 3x thence S 67 N 30 to a post Oak 3x opposite an island  
 thence down the north branch to its confluence with the  
 main River thence up the meanders of said River to the be-  
 ginning together with all and singular the rights members  
 hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or  
 in anywise incident or appertaining to them and to their  
 all and singular the premises before mentioned and unto the  
 Joseph McCullough his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby  
 bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators Jointly  
 and Severally to warrant and for ever defend unto the Said  
 Joseph McCullough his heirs and assigns all and singular the  
 premises above mentioned against our selves and our heirs &  
 against every other person or persons who and so ever lawfully  
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
