Beginning at Hickory thence (turning) S 55 E 58 chains to a Stake X X thence S 50 W 9 chains to a Rock X X thence S 78 W 13 chains 70 links to a stake X X thence S 47 W 58 chains to Hickory on the south side of the River thence up the River N 38 76 16 chains to a red oak corner of Joseph Bradly's Land thence N 6 E crossing the River at the little shoal 45 chains to a stake X X an Morgans line thence with said line N 57 E 50 chains to the Beginning -- Together with all and singular the Rights members heretofore and

Appertinencies to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold in and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James M. Morgan his heirs and assigns forever we do hereby bind our selves our heirs and Executors to warrant and forever defende all and singular the before mentioned unto the the said James M. Morgan his heirs and assigns against ourselves our heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness our hands and seals this 7 day of May A D 1836
