 Granville District and state aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and two dollars to us paid by John Ashmore in full for the District and state aforesaid have granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said Ashmore a shoal mill and part of a tract of Land lying between the district and state aforesaid on both sides of Ruddy River a being part of a tract of Land originally granted to James McWilliams by his Excellency Rufus King Governor on the 24 day of January 1780 the Land to be conveyed beginning at a Spring a white oak below the shoal on the north bank thence across the River to a red Oak near the old store house thence running up to Lone Bridge thence across a bridge 30 feet of said River to Ludwigans Land on stable corner thence up the River to Lewis Rogers Land thence across said River to the mouth of the Branch thence to the beginning including five acres more or less with the shoals & mill to have & hold full and regular to the said Ashmore his heirs and assigns forever and against ourselves our heirs & all other persons in witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 16th day of March 1836 In witness of
